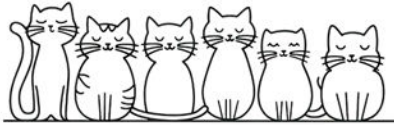
Dating Tip: Treat your date with the same respect you'd give to your favorite feline friend!
